Use of smartphone: Bio-camera and bio-screen as a performer training

Abstract: The present article introduces the concept of bio-camera and bio-screen between the performer's living body and the accessible transmedia object: a smartphone. The point of departure is Kantor's conception of the "bio-object"-as a performer and object that have both treated as dramaturgical material or an artwork.
